

HIREC Signs Agreement with the FIDES Consortium to Provide FIDES Guide Japanese Translation Version in Japan




HIREC Corporation (Head Office: Kawasaki-shi, Kanagawa-ken, Chief Executive Officer: Norimitsu Kamimori; “HIREC”) announced it has signed an agreement with FIDES Consortium*¹ for the sales of the Japanese translation of FIDES Guide*² on June 19th, 2024 at ESTEC (European Space Research and Technology Centre).

This partnership aims to contribute to promote the FIDES in Japan by sales of the FIDES Guide providing the methodology for FIDES reliability analysis, which is currently being introduced in European space sector as a tool for reliability analysis of electronic components onboard spacecraft.
